

## 116<sup>th</sup> Lynnwood Scouts Kit List for Fall Camp

- 1) Sleeping bag suitable for fall and winter conditions (rated to -20C)
- 2) Sleeping pad (Thermo-rest type self inflating air mattress)
- 3) Nalgene water bottle (Wide mouth)
- 4) Net bag for dishes
- 5) Plate, cup (with lid), bowl
- 6) Knife, fork, spoon
- 7) Back pack (60+ litres)
- 8) Zip Lock plastic freezer bags
- 9) Flashlight
- 10) Towel, face cloth
- 11) Sun screen
- 12) Toothpaste
- 13) Tooth brush
- 14) Comb/brush
- 15) Soap
- 16) Insect repellent
- 17) Warm sweater
- 18) Jacket appropriate for weather predicted by forecast
- 19) Wide brimmed hat
- 20) Rain gear (if rain is forecast)
- 21) Toque
- 22) Gloves
- 23) Heavy **WOOL** socks
- 24) Hiking boots
- 25) Rubber boots (if rain is forecast)
- 26) Long underwear
- 27) Long sleeved shirts
- 28) Short sleeved shirts
- 29) Socks
- 30) 6 Grocery bags (no holes)
- 31) Work gloves

A kit inspection will be conducted on October 15, 2009.

Scouts that are unprepared will not be allowed to attend the camp.

These items are required for the protection and safety of your child.

*We use tents and improvised shelters during our camps; as a result, no heat is available to the scouts.*

\* Do **NOT** bring any candy or food, or any electronic devices i.e. Gameboys, MP3 players, cell phones

Folding knives are allowed, however a knife permit is required by the scout in order to use it.
