## Travel directions to Ernest Poole Camp

### Directions

From Edmonton take highway 16 or 16x west to the Wabamun interchange. Proceed south to the Village of Wabamun. Turn right on the Lakeshore Road and follow it (approx 5.5 miles / 9km) to a sharp left turn. The camp is located on your right. Distance form Edmonton approx 80 km (50 miles) and travel time is about 1 hour.
